Welcome to your new and improved Smart Home! First, let us thank you for your patience during the installation of the technology now in your home. The next-generation devices installed in your home not only allow for a better living experience for you, but also enables making future technology even better.

The main component of the automation system is a Samsung SmartThings Hub. This device allows for the control of most power using items in the home, including lighting, outlets, and major appliances. It also enables automation of convenience items such as your HVAC controls and door locks. The Samsung Hub information can be viewed [here](#).

You have also been provided an Amazon Echo, along with an Echo Dot to provide ease of use controlling your new smart home. ## Automation

The system in your home can be customized for how you use it.

You can rename outlets and switches using the Samsung SmartThings App, if you want to call an outlet "Table Lamp" you can do that! Just change the name, and then you can tell Alexa, "Turn off Table Lamp", to control the function.

You can also set the levels of your lights through voice commands, "Alexa, dim kitchen lights to 50 percent" and you will have dimmed kitchen lights.
